<b>Justification</b>	This indicator is linked to USAID's Private Sector Engagement (PSE) Policy, the DOS-USAID Joint Strategic Plan, and USAID Country Development and Cooperation Strategies. This indicator will be used to monitor implementation of the USAID PSE Policy, a finding from The Office of Inspector General's Audit on the USAID PSE Policy.
<b>Definition</b>	<p>This indicator sums the total number of private sector enterprises that the USG worked with in the reporting year.</p> <p>An engagement can be a tangible (e.g., financial assistance, materials, provision of goods and services) or an informational (e.g., convenings, facilitation, strategy development) documented exchange (e.g., memorandum of understanding, strategy, activity design documentation) between a private sector actor(s) and the USG or USG implementer that affects the approach or programmatic strategy or objective in achieving the desired U.S. foreign assistance objective. Instances where private sector enterprises are solely beneficiaries do not count under this indicator, such as activities limited to technical assistance or capacity building for private sector actors (see standard program elements EG.5.1: Business Enabling Environment and EG.5.2: Private Sector Opportunity). 	<p>The private sector is defined as “for-profit, commercial entities and their affiliated foundations; financial institutions, investors and intermediaries; business associations and cooperatives; micro, small, medium and large enterprises that operate in the formal and informal sectors; American, local, regional, and multinational businesses; and For-profit approaches that generate sustainable income (e.g., a venture fund run by a non-governmental organization (NGO) or a social enterprise)” (See USAID’s Private Sector Engagement Policy: <a href="https://www.usaid.gov/sites/default/files/documents/1865/usaid_psepolicy_final.pdf">https://www.usaid.gov/sites/default/files/documents/1865/usaid_psepolicy_final.pdf</a>).</p> <p>There are three disaggregates associated with this indicator:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Type of private sector enterprise:</b> This refers to the types of entities that form the private sector, including for-profit commercial entities, private financial institutions, and corporate foundations. <i>Count the enterprise only once under this disaggregate.</i></li> <li>2. <b>Origin of private sector enterprise:</b> This disaggregate inquires as to whether the enterprise is based in the US, the host country, or elsewhere. Local branches of American multinationals should be counted as US-based. <i>Count the enterprise only once under this disaggregate.</i></li> <li>3. <b>Size of the private sector enterprise:</b> This refers to the number of personnel employed by the private sector enterprise. <i>Count the enterprise only once under this disaggregate.</i></li> </ol> <p><b>Note:</b> This indicator is a snapshot indicator and cannot be summed across reporting years to calculate a total for the life of an activity. Engagements with a private sector enterprise that continue beyond the reporting year should be counted for each reporting year that it is active.</p>
<b>Long Term Linkages</b>	<p>This indicator is linked to USAID’s Private Sector Engagement (PSE) Policy, the DOS-USAID Joint Strategic Plan, and USAID Country Development and Cooperation Strategies. It captures the breadth of private sector engagement to advance U.S. foreign assistance objectives.</p>
