Inclusion

- Cambodia: Can leveraging social networks increase women's likelihood to run for elected local office?
- Mali: Do interethnic indigenous discussion groups contribute to increased tolerance and understanding of diversity?
- Nepal: Does publicizing candidate issue positions increase issue-voting rather than ethnicity patronage voting?



- Transparency & Accountability
- Ghana: Do national government audits or civil society monitoring better hold local government to account?
- Zambia: How does increased information about MP performance affect legislative output and voter behavior?
- Peru: What messages raise public concern with corruption? Do citizens vote against corrupt politicians as a result?



- Haiti: Does free legal assistance reduce pre-trial detention times and how does that effect detainee households?
- Cambodia: What kinds of interventions best reduce vulnerability to human trafficking?
- Burundi & Moldova: Does moving vulnerable children from institutional to home-based care increase their welfare?

- Georgia: To what extent do different civic education approaches increase students' knowledge and engagement?
- Paraguay: Can participatory planning processes improve the economic development outcomes of small-hold farmers?
- Zambia: Can we enable service delivery improvements in the health sector through bottom-up, public pressure?
